1. Medicaid is a welfare program that provides basic health care coverage for seniors, pregnant women, people with disabilities, and some low-income, able-bodied adults. For the past three years, the federal government blocked states from removing people from Medicaid, even people who never qualified for the program or no longer qualify for reasons like increased income or committing welfare fraud. States can now remove people who do not qualify for Medicaid from the program. Results for this poll were collected using a sampling frame from an online panel collected by the Center for Excellence in Polling. The statewide sample is of 383 likely Arkansas voters.

The survey was conducted April 29–May 1, 2023. The margin of sampling error is ± 5.01 percentage points. The margin of sampling error may be higher for subgroups. Results presented may not always appear to total 100 percent due to rounding.

Data were post-stratified using weighted demographic information from the U.S. Census Bureau's Current Population Survey Voting and Registration Supplement and the state election authorities. Demographic information for actual voters in past elections was used to construct sample target weights.
